Here are some examples of the process for different coatings:

Finished Surface



1 Sanding down to bare wood
Sand to bare wood using a minimum of three grit sizes for a smooth finish



2 Primer application
Apply a waterborne primer



3 Intermediate sanding
Fine, intermediate sanding to cut back grain raise



4 Finish application – 2 coats
Apply two consecutive layers of topcoat for total surface protection

The full renovation includes sanding down to bare wood using our range of sanding machines and high-performance abrasives. The sanded-down floor is then retreated with a Bona coat that suits the demands of the surface.

Oiled Surface



1 Sanding down to bare wood
Sand to bare wood using a minimum of three grit sizes for a smooth finish



2 Oil application
Apply oil until wood is saturated



3 Buffing of surface
Buff with woolpad for a superior finish

- + Impregnation of wood, no superficial coating
- + Local repairs possible
- + Dull surfaces, easy to revive
- + Very low VOC



Hard Wax Oiled Surface



1 Sanding down to bare wood
Sand to bare wood using a minimum of three grit sizes for a smooth finish



2 Hard Wax Oil application
Apply Bona Hard Wax Oil



3 Intermediate sanding
Fine, intermediate sanding



4 Hard Wax Oil application
Apply a second layer of Bona Hard Wax Oil
